Unfortunately, there are limitations at this stage around information like goalkicking lists in the football and full match results in the netball. We have been working in the back end to ask for solutions and hopefully they will present themselves in the near future. For the fans that tried to access the

netball results and ladders on their mobile devices from the links on the website, we have been told by Netball Victoria that mobile devices will need to use the Netball Connect app should fans want to filter through the results easier.

We hope that the Council can get the facilities up to scratch in the near future to see action back at Traralgon Recreation Reserve after a long layoff. The senior game there will be the TRFM match of the round. Maffra have their first hit out against East Gippsland rivals Bairnsdale and the Valley will see two of their sides in Morwell and Moe doing battle at Morwell Recreation Reserve. ### **Morwell v Moe**

Morwell take on Moe at Morwell Recreation Reserve with both Senior and A Grade sides fresh off round 1 victories. The Tigers managed to pip Bairnsdale at home in wet conditions in the Seniors however Moe will be much more difficult to get the four points from this weekend. The Lions defeated Warragul at home and their young guns were on show with Harry Pepper kicking 5 goals and Brock Smith being one of the best. Moe should win but the local rivalry matches always throw a few curve balls at stages in the day. In the netball it is a huge matchup this early in the year. Both Moe and Morwell look like they could be the teams to beat in 2022 and will take the first meeting this year as a guide stick for where both sides are at. Former Lion Shannen Freeman was among Morwell's best in round 1 while Moe stars Georgia Moody and Ramayer Gourley were best in their first outing for 2022.

Expect it to be won in the ring with the results reliant on Morwell's ability to cut supply to Moe's shooters and their goaling accuracy.

### **Maffra v Bairnsdale**

Maffra and Bairnsdale are the other local rivalry game for round 2 with the two set to renew hostilities across two venues in Maffra. The court renovations at Maffra Recreation Reserve are not ready yet so netball action moves to the basketball stadium. Both sides are coming off heavy defeats in round one at the hands of Drouin and Morwell. Maffra will be hoping that their goalers can put a winning score on the board this week while Bairnsdale will be relying on their young shooters to do the same. Maffra should win the game but Bairnsdale will be looking to fixtures against their East Gippsland rivals as games they could snatch in 2022. The 2019 senior premiers made a statement last week as they demolished Drouin away from home. Mitch Bennett and Daniel

Bedggood were among the goals with 4 each while midfield stars Ed Carr, Danny Butcher and Alex Carr were all among the best. For Bairnsdale it will be back to the drawing board after they let a golden chance slip against Morwell. Brayden McCarrey was the best with 5 majors for them and will be heavily relied on again for the Red Legs to kick a winning score. Maffra should go in as favorites with their midfield depth the key to victory.

## **Sale v Leongatha**

The senior match of the round comes from Sale with the Magpies set to take on Leongatha. Sale let a lead slip through, letting in 4 final quarter goals. The Magpies looked a better side throughout the day against another premiership rival in Wonthaggi. This week they come up against another premiership fancy in Leongatha. The Parrots managed to get the four points in a tight one against Traralgon in round 1. A toss of the coin match where Sale might get up based on the home ground advantage. This match will be live streamed via Gippsland League TV with the TRFM live call of the match. In A Grade action top five hopefuls Leongatha will go in against the Magpies as hot favorites. Taylah Brown was available for the Parrots last week and topped the MVP votes. If she is available again, they should get home comfortably. Sale were comfortably beaten by Wonthaggi last week and will need to do much better than 18 goals to shoot a winning score against Leongatha. Tegan Blaby and Rachel Ronaldson were their best and will need to fire again to give the Magpies a chance.

## **Drouin v Traralgon**

After a change in venue Drouin will host Traralgon for their scheduled round 2 matches. The Senior Hawks will be thankful that they get a

chance again at home to take on top 5 hopefuls Traralgon. Tom Schneider hit the ground running for the Maroons and with fellow midfielders Haydn Hector and Mark Collison along side him they look to have too much midfield depth for the Hawks. Brett Eddy opened up his Gippsland League account with two goals in round 1 and will be hoping he can kick a bag to lead the Maroons to their first win of the year. In the A Grade match it should be a close game. Drouin managed to easily account for Maffra in round 1 with their defenders doing the job. Traralgon fell short in round one but a big plus was Maddison Stockdale back in goals. Drouin probably have the edge but this match could go either way and will probably be decided in the Maroons ring. If they can get enough supply and shots up expect a close game.

## **Warragul v Wonthaggi Power**

The final match of the round takes place in Warragul with the Power making the trip over the hills. Warragul were competitive against Moe in round 1 and look to be improved from their 2021 form. Wonthaggi started slow and came home strong to beat fellow contender Sale. Ryan Sparkes looked good in his first game for the Power while Tim Knowles and Shannon Bray were great along half back. Wonthaggi should win comfortably unless the Gulls can get in front early. Netball will take place on the Burke Street courts and it should be another close game. The Gulls were beaten by Moe in round 1 but still look one of the better sides in 2022. The Power had a big first up win but face a different level of opponent this week. Wonthaggi could put their trajectory on a path towards the finals if they can produce a strong showing in this game and take the four points. Warragul will still be favorites at home and will be hoping they can get the job done.

## 5 YEARS AGO 14th & 22nd 2017

A split round, with two games on Good Friday and the remainder the following week entertained large crowds. Leongatha won comfortably over Wonthaggi, Zac Vernon and Chris Dunne combining for nine goals for the Parrots. A lightning start by Warragul, eight goals to none in the first quarter, set up the game for the Gulls. Led by Brayden Fowler with nine goals, the Gulls gained a match-winning lead, although Morwell, to their credit, whittled that 48 point lead back to a final 22 point deficit. Sale stunned Drouin with the half time board reading 12.5 to 0.1. Remarkably Drouin won the second half, but the damage had been done. Traralgon came from behind at half time to overrun Moe, Tim Northe (Traralgon) and Daniel Risol (Moe) having a great battle in the midfield. Maffra was too strong for Bairnsdale, the all-round strength of the side shown with eleven goalkickers sharing the Eagles' eighteen goals.

## 10 YEARS AGO 21st April 2012

Sale, Leongatha and Maffra recorded strong wins to fill the top three ladder places. Sale beat Moe by 113 points, with Kane Fraser and Matt Ferguson each contributing six goals. Leongatha stormed home against Traralgon with a nine goal final quarter, Dwayne Holt's six goals leading the way. Maffra took until the final quarter to get any space between themselves and Drouin, again six goals being the match high, this time to the Eagles' Daniel Stubbe. Wonthaggi, with Aaron Ware kicking eight goals, broke away from Bairnsdale after half time, the Power kicking nine goals to five after the main break. The thriller of the round was at Morwell, where the Tigers led by five points deep into the final quarter. With just seconds left on the clock a set shot from Warragul resulted in a behind, the siren sounding on the kick-in. Ben Hughes was a stand-

out for the Gulls with seven goals.

## 40 YEARS AGO 3rd April 1982

An inaccurate Traralgon was very fortunate to take the points against Morwell. The Maroons had 8.17 of an eventual 9.20.74 to lead the Tigers by a comfortable 38 points going in to the final quarter. Morwell had registered just four goals to this stage, but found form in the last to storm home with seven goals, but came up two points short. Ruck-rover combination of Neil Wright and Peter Black proved the difference for the Maroons. Warragul and Yallourn/Yallourn North had hard fought wins over Sale and Moe respectively, while Leongatha and Bairnsdale won by more than a hundred points against Maffra and Newborough. ## 50 YEARS AGO 22nd April 1972

Traralgon and Sale remained unbeaten after Round 2 of 1972 was completed. Traralgon beat Heyfield, but the Maroons did it the hard way with a score of 12.27.99, Paul Chivers chiming in with five goals and Terry Hunter producing one of his classic games. Sale survived a final quarter surge from Moe who reduced a 32 point deficit to just two when the siren sounded. Terry Wynd (Sale) and Ian Jennings (Moe) both kicked four goals. Ken Rohde's five goals led Morwell to a solid win over Maffra, while Clive Salmon and Tim Maxwell combined for ten of Leongatha's 17 goals against Yallourn. Warragul jumped Bairnsdale with an opening term of 6.7 to a behind, going on to win by 94 points. Mick Gargan (7 goals) and Bill Cumming starred for the Gulls.
