It is hard to believe that this was the last Gippsland League football Grand Final that was played all the way back in September 2019 at Traralgon. An interesting note from Paul Carter our League Historian that last weekend Warragul's Jed Lamb kicked all 6 of Warragul's goals became the first time in this league's history (1954 - present) that a player has kicked this many goals to kick his team's total number of goals. There have been a number of occasions where players have kicked a smaller total to have their team's entire complement of goals - for example, this year in Round 4 Thomas Hudson kicked all 4 of Bairnsdale's goals. A check of the records reveals a number of times where a player has kicked 5 out of his team's 6 goals,

however never before have we had a player kick all 6. Amazing stuff for a League as rich in history as our own. The Gippsland League TV matches of the week come from Maffra. Sale and Morwell this week with those fixtures set to be streamed live. We attempted to get our netball match of the month off the ground however with operator shortages we had to postpone or first fixture and will go back to the drawing board with the schedule. 5 YEARS AGO 3rd June 2017

Two final quarter comebacks, both resulting in heart-stopping finishes, highlighted Round 7, 2017. The Maroons led by three points at the final change of ends, then, in a hard fought final quarter, Bairnsdale added two goals to the Maroons' one to win by a solitary point. Dylan Somerville (Bairnsdale) and Bailey Cameron (Traralgon) were their sides' best players, while Damian Cupido's six goal haul for Bairnsdale was crucial to the result. The other thriller was at Maffra where the home team came from fifteen points down at three quarter time to kick four goals to Moe's one to scrape in by three points. Winston Gieschen was best for the Eagles, while Daniel Risol (7 goals) was Moe's best. Leongatha overcame a slow start to wrest control of their game against Sale to go on to win by thirty points, Cade Maskell their best. Chris Dunne (Leongatha) and Jordan Dessent (Sale) got five goals each. A six goal third quarter saw Morwell break away from Warreagul, Brandon McDonald kicking six goals for the Tigers. Drouin jumped Warragul on the Sunday with a five goal opening term, however they failed to kick another goal for the remainder of the match. The Parrots travelled to Bairnsdale and opened with a bang . . . nine goals in the first quarter and six in the second saw them leading by 61 points at the main break. Jake Best (9 goals) and Dwayne Holt (6) led the way as the Parrots won by 108 points. Moe overcame a seven point half time deficit against Warragul to run away with the game after half time. The Lions kicked twelve goals to four in the latter half, Ben Kerrigan best afield and Stuart Robertson ever-elusive

Morwell led Wonthaggi from start to finish, Traralgon kicked away with seven goals in the third quarter against Drouin and, despite shocking inaccuracy in front of goals, Sale trounced Maffra. Winning each of the first three quarters, Leongatha had a comfortable lead over Sale, then added 7.5 in the final term. Michael Roughead and Paul Heppell were best for the Parrots with Tony Waters kicking six goals. Richard Coulthard kicked five of Sale's eight goals. Warragul and Traralgon fought out an epic tussle, neither team comfortable until the Gulls edged away in the final quarter. Rob Ballingall was at his usual best in the middle for Warragul. Brett Stanistreet led Morwell to a 47 point win over Yallourn/Yallourn North, Newborough got up for its second win in three games against Maffra and Bairnsdale stormed home with seven goals to overrun Moe.

50 YEARS AGO 27th May 1972

The top four teams in Traralgon, Sale, Moe and Warragul all won, as expected. Traralgon maintained its unblemished record against Maffra, but there was little between the two all afternoon. Brian Hammond (Traralgon) and Barry Marsden (Maffra) both scored five goals. Sale and Bairnsdale both kicked six goals in the first half before Sale unleashed a barrage of majors in the second half. The Magpies added eight goals in each of the latter terms to win by 104 points. Trevor Somerville led the way with seven goals, with Brian Cashman and Ian Jones each contributing five goals. Moe was in control of its game against Leongatha in the early stages before the Parrots hit back to tie the scores at three quarter time. Straight kicking in the final term saved Moe as they kicked 3.1 to Leongatha's 2.6 to win by a point. Steve Janeczek and Brian "Doc" Rowlings were best for Moe, while the Tonys, Johnston and Ireland, were named as best for the Parrots. Col Metcalf and Steve Szabo led Morwell to a 19 point win over Yallourn, the Tigers five goal third term proving the difference. Warragul kicked five goals to one against Heyfield in the third term to break the game open. Bill Cumming, Gerry Lynn and Bob Baldry were best for the Gulls.




