GCASA approach AFL Gippsland with "Orange Round" concept. Project proposal is developed and approved by AFLG board of management

2015

Gippsport and GWH join GCASA and AFLG to organise and execute the first annual Orange Round. 10 football netball clubs participated from the AFL Gippsland League

2016

Orange Round second annual event, games were held across the 6 Gippsland leagues with two teams from each league participating

2017

This year Orange Round had gained momentum and clubs were contacting to be involved. This occurred across a split round with clubs in WGFNL, MGFNL, NGFNL, FNEG

2018

Introduction of Orange Round Ambassadors. Gender Equality in Sport =Everybody wins logo was created. Round held again across split round within AFL Gippsland League

2019

Orange Round Committee joined with Change for Sam Committee in Bass Coast for an Orange Round on Phillip Island. Orange Round was also held within Gippsland Soccer League for the first time.

WHAT IS ORANGE ROUND?

Orange Round is a Gippsland wide initiative to encourage sports club to take a stand and help raise awareness about the incidence and impacts of sexual assault, family violence and violence against women and girls in our community. As well as, raise awareness about how we can create a community culture that promotes equality and respect.

The concept of the Gippsland Orange Round arose from the United Nations International Orange Day; an Initiative which aims to raise awareness about Violence against Women and Girls on the

25th day of any month, inspiring anyone in the world to organise an event/s to work towards reducing violence against women and girls.

The initiative has been running since 2015 and is a collaborative partnership between Gippsland Centre against Sexual Assault (GCASA), AFL Gippsland, GippSport, Gippsland Women's Health and Netball Victoria.

5 YEARS AGO 1st July 2017

Moe's upset win over Traralgon saw just four premierships points separating the top four teams. Inaccuracy in the first half saw the Maroons (2.11.23) seventeen points down at half time. Tom Long led a tight backline for the Lions, with Luke Webber (4 goals) and centremen James Blaser (3) the main goalscorers. Ruckman Ben Amberg was best for Traralgon. Morwell set the tone for the match against Warragul with a six goal to one opening term. Robert Michaelides and Hayden Britten played outstanding games for the Tigers, with Gulls' duo Nate Paredes and Brad Scalzo again to the fore. Just three goals, all to Sale, were kicked in the opening half at Drouin before the Magpies hit their straps with four goals in the third and a mighty ten goal final quarter. Maffra's eight goal third quarter put the result of its match with Bairnsdale beyond doubt. Daniel Bedggood leading the way for the Eagles with five goals. Leongatha won all four quarters against Wonthaggi in their eighty point win, Zac Vernon and Luke Bowman dominant on ball.

10 YEARS AGO 30th June 2012

While there were no upset results in Round 11 of 2012, Drouin's trip to Maffra almost caused the upset of the season. Drouin sat seventh on the league table and travelled east to the ground that all teams have had trouble on in recent years. A close first half saw the Eagles ahead by six points, but it looked as though Maffra had put the game beyond doubt when they added seven third quarter goals to lead by 35 points at the final change of ends. The Hawks, led by Pat McGrath and Bob McCallum, came home with five unanswered goals to be just five points short at the final siren. Ladder leader Sale took some time to shake off Moe, but drew away after the half time break. Luke Collins and Kane Martin controlled the midfield, James Blaser also giving the Lions great drive. Wonthaggi took no time in putting its stamp on its game against Bairnsdale, the Power kicking seven goals one to one behind in the first term. Leongatha and Traralgon fought a dour struggle

in a game which produced just nine goals, while Morwell, although terribly inaccurate, was too strong for Warragul.

40 YEARS AGO 19th June 1982

Arch rivals Morwell and Traralgon celebrated their centenary of matches against each other with a match for the ages. In front of past players from as far back as the 1920s, the teams went as hard as any of their predecessors. Inaccuracy plagued the Tigers (7.17.59) who were 19 points down at the final break. Morwell mounted a challenge in the final term, adding six goals to Traralgon's three, the scores level late in the game. The Tigers managed the final goal to score a six point win. Traralgon coach Peter Hall was at his inspirational best, as was Morwell's Brett Stanistreet. Star forward John Featherston kicked five goals for the winners with Traralgon's Bernie Massey on target with six. Leongatha and Bairnsdale gained comfortable wins over Maffra and Newborough respectively, while Yallourn/Yallourn North and Warragul had to fight to the siren for their wins over Moe and Sale.

50 YEARS AGO 1st July 1972

The top of the table clash between Moe and Sale didn't live up to the hype as Moe took charge of the game, leading by 7, 29 and 46 points at the breaks in play. Barry Rowlings and Dennis Stevens were outstanding for the Lions as they cruised to a 39 point win. Bairnsdale had a hard earned nine point win over Warragul, the Redlegs' six goal first quarter proving to be the match-winner. Maffra came from seven points down at three quarter time against Morwell to kick four goals to one to take the points. Brian Shingles (Maffra) and Carl Vesty (Morwell) were named as their teams' best players. Gray "Fluffy" Malone and Russell Donaldson led the second half revival for Traralgon against Heyfield, Traralgon kicking six goals to two in the latter half of the game, Eric Gray topscoring for the Maroons with four goals. Goals were hard to get at Leongatha with the Parrots and Yallourn combining for just eleven goals for the match. The nine point win was Leongatha's first home ground win for the season. Eric Peters and Alan Beasley were best for Leongatha, with "Jock" Welsh and Barry Mathison best for the Blues.

Mitchell was recruited from Sale City in 2016 to fill the goal kicking void left by the departure of Darren Sheen and Gary Jones. Having broken into the Sale City seniors at a young age he had established a reputation as an elusive opportunist forward with a deadly left foot.

A proven goal kicker he had kicked 165 goals from his 84 games with the Dogs.

Upon his arrival, Mitchell was an immediate success. In his debut season he played every game, led the club goal kicking, played in a premiership and won the best on ground medal in the grand final.

More success followed in Season 2017 and Season 2018 finishing with 50+ goals in both years and topping the League goal kicking list in 2017. The downside in these two years being the two grand final losses to Leongatha.

In 2019, Mitchell racked up his 200th goal for the club in only his fourth season and tasted premiership success again. His 5-goal haul in the grand final earning him BOG status from the 3TR commentators. His 2 goals from point blank range in the frantic final quarter, including the sealer, will be long remembered.

Mitchell has been a model of consistency and dependency with his 100 games coming from a possible 103. His tally includes twelve (12) finals of which four (4) have been grand finals.

In the long history of the club, he is only



the 14th player to reach the 200 goals milestone. He has a best haul of nine (9), achieved against the arch enemy Sale. He currently sits ninth on the all-time list of goals kicked for the club.
