

5 YEARS AGO 8th July 2017

Leongatha held on to top spot on the ladder, scraping home at Moe by a solitary point. The Parrots had trailed the Lions at all three breaks but, in a tense final quarter, scored the only major for the term to hang on as Moe's Tom Long marked in the forward pocket a second after the siren sounded. Aaron Coyle led a solid Leongatha backline, James Blaser on top in the midfield for the home side. The other thriller was at Warragul where the home side held off a fast finishing Bairnsdale to win by seven points. Brad Scalzo and Nate Paredes were prominent for the Gulls in the middle, with Bairnsdale'defender David Donchi named as his team's best player. Wonthaggi, led by Jack Blair's five goal haul, was too strong for Drouin. Maffra's forward duo Daniel Bedggood and Darren Sheen combined for nine of the Eagles' 15 goals as they won comfortably against Morwell, Traralgon's Lee Stockdale and Luke DiCiero doing likewise for the Maroons' win over Sale. Morwell's surprise win over Leongatha showed that the competition for the flag was more than just Sale and Leongatha. Tom Crosby was dominant in the ruck, well supported by Michael "Funky" Duncan and the livewire Mannon Johnston, who topped off his game with four goals. The Tigers led from start to finish with an eventual comfortable margin in their favour of 38 points. Ladder leader Sale was also made to work hard for their premiership points by Drouin, eventually drawing away for a good win. The Joshes, Dunkley and Kennedy, were named as the Magpies' best. Wonthaggi kept their finals chances alive with a professional display against Moe, Aaron Ware outstanding with five goals. Lee Stockdale kicked six goals for Traralgon as the Maroons had a thumping 98-point win against Bairnsdale, while Maffra's eleven goal second quarter put any doubt about the winner to rest as they went in at half time leading by 68 points. Adrian Burgiel and Daniel Bedggood combined for half of the Eagles' 26 goals.

Leongatha blew its early chances by posting 2.8 in the first quarter against Traralgon. 40 YEARS AGO 26th June 1982

Top teams Morwell and Leongatha were seriously challenged by Bairnsdale and Warragul respectively before showing the class that had them at the top of the tree. Just seven points separated Morwell and Bairnsdale at the last change and it wasn't until late in the final guarter that the Tigers felt that they had won the game. Rob Dickson and David Allison were best for Morwell, while Bruce Cowell and Wayne Royal shone for the Redlegs. Early inaccuracy stopped Warragul from grabbing the advantage against Leongatha, the Gulls leading at quarter time 3.8 to 1.3, Colin Boyd, along with the brothers Salmon, Brian and lan, led the revival which saw the Parrots add seven, and then another six goals. Undaunted, Warragul came home with five goals. Sale took until the final quarter to put any space between themselves and Newborough in a match which produced 34 goals. Gary Pleming was best afield, his strong marking in the Magpies' forward line a feature of the game. Joe Albanese's six goal haul led Traralgon to a 24 point win over Yallourn/Yallourn North, rover Neil Meredith best for the Blues. Moe came from ni ne points down at three quarter time to kick four goals to one to overrun Maffra, Sean Keenan best on the day with six goals. 50 YEARS AGO 8th July 1972

In a round of upsets, top two Moe and Sale were beaten by Morwell and Warragul respectively, and bottom team Yallourn came from behind to beat third placed Traralgon. Morwell led Moe at every change, Carl Vesty and Steve Edwards supporting ruckman Steve Szabo as the Tigers prevailed by fifteen points. Sale jumped out quickly against Warragul, leading by thirty points at quarter time, 6.1 to 1.1, however the lead was gone by half time as the Gulls kicked five unanswered goals. The second half was a slog, Warragul adding three goals to Sale's one, Bruce Davidson and Malcolm Birch named as best for the winner. Yallourn trailed Traralgon and each of the three breaks before kicking three goals to one to snatch a thrilling three point win. Robert "Jock" Welsh and big Barry Mathison starred for the Blues. Maffra led Heyfield from start to finish, while it took an eight goal final term for Leonoatha to overtake Bairnsdale.


