Leongatha and Maffra remained two games clear at the top of the ladder, but neither team was convincing in their wins over fifth and sixth placed Morwell and Wonthaggi. Leongatha led at the last change by just eight points, before pulling away to a 31 point win against Morwell, Cameron Stone and Luke Bowman among their best. Maffra trailed Wonthaggi going in to the final quarter and, in a dour struggle, the Eagles kicked two goals to one to claw their way to a two point win. On ballers Jack Johnstone (Maffra) and Aiden Lindsay (Wonthaggi) stood out for their respective teams. Sale scored a much needed win over Warragul, the Magpies coming from behind at half time. Traralgon, led by great games from Matt Northe and Mark Collison (6 goals) were too strong for Drouin. A strong win by Sale at Traralgon kept the Magpies four points clear at the top of the Gippsland League ladder. Led by Matt Ferguson (6 goals) and Kane Fraser (4), Sale powered away from the Maroons after half time, taking the margin from seven points to 67. The defeat left Traralgon vulnerable in fifth spot, however Wonthaggi missed a golden opportunity of drawing level on points with Traralgon when held to a single first half goal by Drouin. Pat McGrath and Anthony Tipungwuti were dominant in the midfield for Drouin. Morwell, with five goals each from Mannon Johnston and Daniel Hutchison, were too strong for Moe as were Leongatha against Warragul. Jake Best and Dwayne Holt combined for eleven of the Parrots' seventeen goals. Bairnsdale gave Maffra a fright early on in their match, the Redlegs kicking seven goals in the first quarter. It was all Maffra after that, however, the Eagles adding seventeen goals to five after the first break.

The close match of the round was at Traralgon, although it was Sale's final quarter comeback that reduced the margin to nineteen points. Maffra came home with six goals to one. As expected, Morwell was too strong for Churchill, the forward pairing of Dean Caldow (6 goals) and Paul McCulloch (5) too much for the Kangaroos' defenders. The shock of the round was at Bairnsdale where the Redlegs got away early against Moe and never let up, winning by 37 points. Robert Bridger got the job on star forward Ken Rainstord, and kept him to a solitary goal.

Traralgon accounted for Maftra comfortably, Bairnsdale led all day against Sale but weren't safe until the final siren and a big third quarter saw Moe claim the points against Newborough.

50 YEARS AGO 22nd July 1972

Moe looked in trouble against Yallourn at half time with a scoreline of 3.11.29, but really turned it on in the second half. The Lions, led by Dennis Stevens and Rex Daly, rattled on seven goals in the third quarter and then a further eight goals in the final term, their five point half time deficit becoming a winning margin of 74 points. Greg McNaughton and Wayne Morris, backed by five goals from Barry Jefferies, saw Sale to a comfortable win over Heyfield. The Leongatha versus Traralgon game was a thriller. A goal down at quarter time, Traralgon gained the lead to be eight points ahead at half time and seven points ahead at the final change. Midfielders Gray Malone and Brian Hammond rallied the Maroons to hang on to win by four points. Better players for the Parrots were Clive Salmon and Ivan Rasmussen. Jeff Gieschen was the star for Maffra in their win over Bairnsdale. Morwell jumped to a five goal quarter time lead against Warragul, and won by that margin.


