ROLLING SUBS TRIALED



It was a new look A Grade netball match in Round 18 as the Alinta Energy Gippsland League trialed rolling substitutes for the first time.

Morwell A Grade had already secured the minor premiership and were scheduled to play Sale in the Round 18 match. The League had flagged with clubs earlier in the year that it would trial the proposed rule introductions towards the end of the season. Both clubs were eager participants in the trial and embraced being the first two teams to be apart of the exciting new change.

The proposed changes, which will likely be implemented in 2023, will see all teams across the six grades of competition have access to substitutions during live play in matches. Currently teams are only allowed to make substitutions at quarter breaks and if there is a case of an injured player. The rolling substitutions will give the ability for the teams to make changes at any time during the match without halting the play.

Sale had the honor of implementing the first ever live substitute. A Grade coach Jo Ballinger who has worked under the rules in her Victorian Netball League commitments said "The changes are great for the clubs and the players. It allows coaches more flexibility to make changes. The rolling subs work great at VNL level and should be a big positive for the Gippsland League"

Morwell also embraced the new rules and are eager to see them introduced "It was actually a lot of fun. In the last quarter we trialed some players in new positions and the girls on the bench stayed

more engaged with the game as they could be put back in at any time. We tried Shannon Freeman in the mid court, Court Garth as a shooter which is something we wouldn't have been able to do under normal conditions" said coach Rachael Paterson

The Alinta Energy Gippsland League were at the match to ensure that the teams had support to operate under the proposed changes and to assist the coaches, team managers and scorers work through the administration side of the proposed changes.

"The rolling substitutes is a change that should be a great benefit for our community sporting players. The change fits in perfectly with the direction of the League's newly implemented strategic plan in the areas of leadership and embracing change in the community sporting landscape" said Alinta Energy Gippsland League General Manager Daniel Heathcote

"It was great to see both Morwell and Sale embrace the trial. Both teams were utilizing their players in different positions and not having players be benched for large portions of the match. We hope in 2023 that it will allow clubs to have more participants in their teams, especially the junior sides and not have to turn players away due to lack of ability to promise playing time"

It is a change that the League was looking to implement in 2022, however off the back of the interrupted seasons the decision was made to trial and develop the administrative process for the updated rules with the view to permanently implementing in 2023.

5 YEARS AGO 2nd & 3rd September 2017

Maffra and Traralgon kicked off the 2017 Finals Series at Sale in a match where goals were hard to come by. In fact it took until the 10 minute mark of the second term for Traralgon to get their first major. Maffra led by 20 points, then 8 and 5 at the final change, the teams combining for just nine goals to that stage. Traralgon gained the lead when Matt Northe goalied after just 15 seconds of the final term starting. After a couple of lead changes Lee Stockdale kicked the Maroons out to an 8-point lead at the 20 minute mark, with Jay Neagle icing the game five minutes later. Bailey Cameron was rock solid in defence for Traralgon, while Ben Amberg was the dominant ruckman on the day. Kel Porter and Mitch Bennett were lively for the Eagles.

Moe and Morwell met for the second week running, as the pair had met at Moe in Round 18. Moe won that encounter by 37 points, and the Elimination Final followed that game as Moe went in at half time with a lead of 27 points. Moe's experienced brigade of Peter Ainsworth, Tom Long and James Blaser led the way for the Lions as they maintained their lead for the third term, then came home with four goals to Morwell's two. Onballers Joel Soutar and Anthony Rosato gave great drive for the Tigers.

10 YEARS AGO 1st & 2nd September 2012

Maffra made a big statement in the way it defeated Leongatha in the Qualifying Final on the Saturday of the first week of the 2012 Finals Series. The Eagles and Leongatha were evenly matched for the first and most of the second quarter, but approaching half time Maffra gained a handy break. Adrian Burgiel and Daniel Bedgood were giving the Parrots plenty of trouble up forward. Ben Coleman, Kel

Porter and Brent Connelly took control of the midfield after the long break as Maffra powered away. The Eagles kicked 17 goals to 7 in the latter half to record an emphatic 88 point victory.

Arch rivals Morwell and Traralgon faced off in the Elimination Final at Traralgon on the Sunday. Like the Qualifying Final, it was in the second term that Traralgon made its move, leading by 35 points at half time. Morwell won both the third and final quarters, but couldn't make up the leeway. The win came at a cost to the Maroons with injuries to Michael Geary (foot) and Joe Caldwell (hamstring) with star forward Dan McKenna concussed five minutes into the final quarter. Matt Jones and Jackson Hall were solid in defence for Traralgon while Tom Crosby and Jeff Ryan were named as the best two for the Tigers.

20 YEARS AGO 8th September 2002

Momentum at finals time is very important to a team's prospects of success. Traralgon entered the 2002 finals on a three game losing run, including losses to Leongatha and Sale who were outside the top Four. Blustery conditions greeted the players at Maffra and played a part in some early inaccuracy by both teams. With a fourteen point half time lead Moe was in control, but not dominating the game. The third quarter was where the match was decided. With Matt Forsys providing a great marking target, the Lions kicked six goals to one to put the issue beyond doubt, going on to win by 62 points, which remains to this day Moe's biggest win over Traralgon since 1973. Warragul set about making sure that they weren't going to lose another one as they peppered the goals to gain a three goal quarter time lead. Rob Ballingall was in sparkling form in the centre and forward Robert Dean kicked two of his four goals in the opening term. The issue of the outcome of the game was put to rest by half time as the Gulls rampaged their way to a 63 point half time lead, adding 7.5 to Bairnsdale's two behinds. Bairnsdale, the 1981 Premier team, rallied after half time, led by Glenn Calvert, Tom Alvin and Murray Frew, outscoring Warragul in both the third and the final quarters, but the deficit was too great.

As the VFL embarked on its first year of running a Final Five Finals Series, the innovative LVFL was in its third year of the Bill Watts designed Final Six. The first weekend saw Traralgon (3rd) meet Maffra (6th) at Moe on the Saturday and Warragul (4th) play Morwell (5th) at Morwell on the Sunday. Both games were Elimination Finals and went according to ladder positions with Traralgon and Warragul winning their ways to Week 2.

In the final washup Traralgon's first quarter where they established a 21-point lead was critical in the final result where they won by a margin of 18 points. Charlie Healey was the best player of the day, controlling the ball around the packs. Dennis McGrath played arguably his best game for Traralgon, with Brian Hammond the general in the centre. As Maffra fought back, led by Geoff Sinclair and Jeff and Robert Gieschen, Russell Donaldson played a vital role at centre half back for the Maroons in turning back attack after attack to ensure Traralgon's advantage.

On Sunday Warragul had to come from a nine point half time deficit and again it was one particular quarter which defined the match. Warragul's third term, where they added four goals to Morwell's two, took them to a narrow lead at three quarter time. Gerry Lynn and Bob Baldry were best for the Gulls, with Roly Nicholson, who had returned to Warragul from VFA club Sunshine, providing a great forward target. Col Metcalf, captain-coach Fred Swift and Max McMahon led the way for the Tigers who were unlucky to be five points behind as the final siren sounded.

Even their last two finals meetings, the 2014 Preliminary Final and the 2015 Elimination Final, were thrillers, the Power winning both, but by just two and three points respectively. Who will ever forget Wonthaggi's barnstorming finish in 2014 when they came from 45 points down at three quarter time to kick 7.5 to 0.0 to win in the dying seconds. Well, sit back and enjoy what may well go down as another (extra time?) thrilling encounter, the winner to challenge Leongatha for a place in this year's Grand Final.

Notes: Every league has "arch rivalries" and few, if any, come bigger or better than Morwell playing Traralgon. The rivalry is well over one hundred years old, the teams first met of the field in 1882, and they met by mutual arrangement, or by entering the same Challenge Cups. Since Traralgon returned to the Central Gippsland league in 1936 the Tigers and Maroons have been in the same competition. They were the dominant sides of the 1960s, meeting in no fewer than five Grand Finals in that decade, then met again in another six Grand Finals between 1983 and 1993 to consolidate the rivalry. Finals meetings in recent years have been scarce with just two (2010 Qualifying Final and 2012 Elimination Final) coming since 1998. Morwell was expected by many to be in a rebuild this year after many losses through clearances to the Senior team, but the young side has far exceeded those expectations to rise from eighth last year into the finals. Traralgon is a class act which can be considered mightily unlucky to not be in a Qualifying Final as their six losses for the year were by a total of just 41 points, which includes running the champion Leongatha team to margins of just 7 and 3 points. These are two in form teams which will do their predecessors of 140 years proud.
