PAST FINAL ROUND 3s

5 YEARS AGO 16th September 2017

Maffra performed a 43-point turnaround in beating Traralgon in the Preliminary Final of 2017. Beaten by Traralgon by 18 points a fortnight earlier in the Qualifying Final, Maffra came from four points down going in to the final quarter. Darren Sheen ran in to an open goal in the first minute of the final quarter to reclaim the lead for the Eagles, the seventh lead change of the match. Kade Renooy had kicked three of Maffra's first five goals; he added two more in the space of four minutes, followed by goals to Mitch Bennett, Daniel Bedggood and Jack Johnstone, all the while holding Traralgon scoreless. By this stage, the 23 minute mark, the game was effectively over as Maffra had skipped 33 points ahead. Kel Porter and Alex Carr dominated at the stoppages for Maffra, although Traralgon ruckman Ben Amberg won the hit-outs. Renooy, Bedggood and Bennett outperformed their Traralgon counterparts, of whom Dylan Loprese (3 goals) was their best.

10 YEARS AGO 15th September 2012

Maffra advanced to the 2012 Grand Final after a thrilling match against Leongatha. The Parrots showed amazing accuracy in front of goal for three quarters, having a score of 13.1.79 on the board when Dwayne Holt kicked the 7th of his eight goals at the 24 minute mark of the third quarter. From that point on Leongatha added 2 goals 7 and went down by a solitary point. Leongatha had opened brightly with six straight goals in the first term to hold a handy 16 point lead at quarter time. The dynamic duo of Dwayne Holt and Jake Best combined for four, two each, of those goals and signalled that they would take some stopping. Maffra scored three goals for the term, all by star forward Adrian Burgiel. The teams went goal-for-goal in the second term with the result that the margin remained unchanged at half time. Maffra attacked relentlessly during the third quarter, led by their on-ballers Alex Carr. Ben Coleman and Gary Jones, but the Eagles never at any stage hit the front, the margin in single figures from the ten minute mark onwards, Leongatha ahead by one point at the final change. Holt had seven goals to this stage and was ably supported by Zac Vernon and David Gourdis. With a goal at the four minute mark by Kel Porter, Maffra hit the front for the first time since the five minute mark of the first quarter. With goals to Holt and Otto Leongatha were ten points ahead, but Maffra hadn't finished yet.

Carr scored his fourth goal at the 19 minute mark to bring Maffra back to a four point deficit. Leongatha had chances to put the game beyond doubt, but managed four successive behinds. Just minutes from the final siren, Daniel Bedggood marked and goaled to get Maffra back the lead and, in the dying seconds of the game, a young Parrot had the ball at his forward 50, ignored a couple of leads and had a shot at goal, which was cleared by the Maffra defenders who soon after celebrated the final siren sounding.

20 YEARS AGO 14th September 2002

The 2002 Preliminary Final will long be remembered for the blistering second half of Wonthaggi. The Blues got an early advantage over Moe with a three goal lead at quarter time, with Moe fighting back to bring the deficit down to just ten points at half time. The Lions had actually hit the front briefly at the 20 minute mark before a pair of late goals to Wonthaggi wrested back the lead. A nip and tuck second half was anticipated, with many feeling that Moe was beginning to have an edge over Wonthaggi. The third term blew all that anticipation out of the water. Blues' forward Tim Hooper was simply unstoppable, kicking six of Wonthaggi's incredible eleven goals in the term. Facing a 65 point mountain to climb, the Lions bravely fought out the game and kicked five goals in the final term. Hooper, wingman Josh Olden and onballer Adam Mabilia were named as their best.


