Round 2 is here after the Easter break and it is yet another highly anticipated schedule of matches ahead. The center piece of the Saturday schedule is the Battle for South Gippy with Leongatha hosting rivals Wonthaggi. The Power were the last team to beat Leongatha in the seniors all the way back in the corresponding clash in 2021. The Parrots will be unveiling their Senior and Reserve premierships on the day which will be a highlight for the club. Sunday sees yet another big matchday with Sale hosting Bairnsdale. The netball sides go in both with first round wins and their round 2 clash will be live on Optus Gippsland League TV. For those interested in a statistics from Round 1, Paul Carter has pulled down some interesting stats about the Maffra Bairnsdale draw. This draw is just the second for Maffra's Senior team in this league, their other drawn match coming in Round 6, 1963 against Yallourn.

The league's average for drawn matches is around 1 per 100 matches. Yesterday's game was Maffra's 1159th since joining the league in 1960. The drawn

match is just the second time in league history (1954 – present) that an opening round match has been drawn, the other tied opening round match being between Warragul and Trafalgar in 1965. Maffra and Bairnsdale were old adversaries in the old Gippsland Football League. The last time these teams drew a match with each other was in Round 12, 1951 at Maffra. The last time they drew at Bairnsdale was in Round 2, 1947.

ROUND 1

150 Games

James Read (Maffra)

James "Froggy" Read will play his 150th senior game this weekend.

James had his first association with the MFNC way back in 2009 when he played a single game in the Under 16's on permit from Stratford. In 2011 (as a bottom-aged thirds player) he played 16 games in the thirds and doubled up on a number of occasions to play 11 games in the reserves. These games included four finals and culminated in being a member of the reserves premiership side under the coaching of Andrew Dunsmuir.

With a Reserves premiership under his belt and following a big pre-season, in 2012 as a top-age Under 18 player Froggy was selected for his first senior game against Morwell in Round 1. James held his spot in the senior side until suffering a broken leg late in the season. After rehab and another big pre-season James was back in the seniors in 2013. In 2016, James played every home and away game and three finals including the remarkable win over the heavily fancied Leongatha in the Grand Final.

The next year, when Froggy played his 100th game it was generally accepted that he was one of the youngest (if not the youngest) player in the history on the club to reach that milestone. Disaster struck just weeks later when he suffered another season-ending injury when he did his knee in the Qualifying Final. His absence was keenly felt, particularly in the one-point loss in the Grand Final.

After missing all of the 2018 season, Froggy returned in round 1, 2019. He played every game and won his second premiership medal in the classic encounter against Leongatha. His spoil and follow up smother, preventing an almost certain Leongatha goal in the hectic last quarter, will be long remembered.

James' has been tested over his career suffering two serious injuries since his debut. It is a credit to his character, resilience and dedication that he has been able to overcome these setbacks and return to the playing field.

Over the course of his career James has been a stalwart in defence, regularly taking on and beating opposition key forwards with his defensive work and strong spoiling. With his no fuss approach, strong work ethic and attention to preparation, combined with his Reserves and Senior Premiership successes, Froggy is a much-respected member of the playing group.

Good luck this weekend Froggy and may you play many more games for the "good old red and black".
