ALL STARS WRAP UP



During the bye weekend the League produced our inaugural Virtue Homes All Stars event. As some of the media outlets reported we are the only regional League in the state to get this sort of concept onto the schedule and the initiative was certainly well received by our participants. Unfortunately, the wet weather in the morning impacted the event early but the standard of competition in the junior grades despite the conditions was at an extremely high level. The junior football match saw the best talent from both the U16s and U18s compete, and teams were basically at full strength outside the players who had Gippsland Power duties. A huge thankyou goes to our two coaches Declan Keilty (Team Red) and Adrian Burgiel (Team Navy) for the hard work and time they invested in the lead up and for the match day. These two sides will see all players invited to be in the train on squad for the Gippsland Junior Interleague Carnival. Adding the All-Star event in the lead up should give a boost to the final Gippsland League side for that event. The junior netball teams were made up of our Association Championships squads and some other select players from around the League. These sides also will use the event as a launching pad into the Association Championships tournament. The junior matches were an incredibly high standard on the day and it was great to see the players enjoying being a part of their All Star regions.

The open netball game was also a spectacle and showed the depth in the Gippsland League competition. Team Red led by coach Stacie Gardiner ended up with the win on the day and we thank all the players who put their hand up and the girls who stepped into the sides after last minute injuries. We hope that the senior program may lead into a return of our senior aged representative team at the Association Championships finals. Thanks to Team Navy coach Rach Paterson also for her time in getting the Navy side on the court and being part of the promotion in the lead in. The Senior/U25's football

had a lot of external interest, and the final product didn't let anyone down. The match provisions were 16 on the field and 4 interchange which saw the play really open up taking out four players from the field. The ball flowed and despite some wet conditions at times the standard was very high from both sides. Team Navy was led by Boyd Bailey and had excellent buy in from all the players invited. There were several VFL listed players and stars of the competition running around and it was great to see the teams from the Central & East gel together. Thanks to all the players and Boyd for their hard work and to Maffra FNC for hosting the Navy trainings. Team Red was originally led by Jed Lamb until a serious knee injury in the lead up ruled him out of the game and unable to coach. Moe assistant coach Shane Paynter stepped up and assisted by Moe senior coach Declan Keilty the Red team got off the ground and was ultra-competitive. A huge thanks to Shane for his work in the lead up and all the Team Red players who put their hand up to play. There were 6-8 players that pulled out due to injury in the final two weeks and to have the standard of players willing to step up was great and showed that there is real depth in the West. Thanks to Moe FNC for hosting the West trainings and to Traralgon FNC for hosting the overall event. A final shout out to our League Manager Brandon Milburn for all his hard work in getting the concept off the ground. He spent hours on the phone and with the coaches making sure the players were ready to go. Sometimes people don't fully grasp the work that goes into these programs and when 6 players from South Gippsland pull out of the Senior football team with a week to go it is a huge effort to replace players last minute from a small pool of clubs to ensure that the event goes on. Amazing effort Brandon and to all the coaches and volunteers who made the event a success.
