200 Senior Games

Ben Morrow (Moe)

Moe ruckman Ben Morrow is set to play his 200th senior game this weekend.

The veteran will become just the 11th Moe player to reach the landmark when the Lions travel to Bairnsdale in Round 10.

He already has 200 club games to his name, and is only half-a-dozen matches away from also chalking up 250 total games in the maroon and blue.

On field, there has been a number of senior finals, as well as a reserves premiership in 2009.

His love for the game is so much so he even played a year in Queensland while the entire state of Victoria was in lockdown, winning a senior flag in the tropics.

He has stuck by Moe through the highs and lows, including some very tough years as senior captain from 2014–16.

A consistent performer, he has often finished among the top place-getters in the best-and-fairest, and his durability is such that he has rarely missed a game.

The Morrow name features heavily at Moe FNC.

Mother Karen works the canteen, and father Darren, who played more than 100 games himself, has served a number of key off field roles.

Ben has played alongside younger brother Lachlan, and cousins Sam, Tyler, Justin and Trent (also the club's current strength and conditioning coach). Brother Matt (unable to ever play due to injury) has also been a team official.

Congratulations to Haydn Hector who played his 100th Senior game milestone against Sale last weekend.

Haydn played his first senior game for TFNC in 2009 at age 16, and since then, he has proven himself time and time again to be one of the hardest competitors we've seen. Haydn is hard running, tough as nails and has a never-give-up attitude, which, combined with his elite skills, make him an asset to the team.

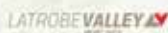
