by ruckman Neil Wright. Tom Beveridge led a solid backline for Traralgon, restricting the Redlegs to one goal in the third quarter, the lead at the final change of ends a match winning 44 points. Bairnsdale coach Trevor Fletcher called on his troops for a last ditch effort. Glen Calvert and rover Chris Redenbach led the charge, but Traralgon was able to answer every challenge, the teams breaking close to even for the term, the Maroons destined for a showdown with arch rival Morwell.

Notes: Leongatha and Moe meet in their fourth Preliminary Final, the latest of which was at Morwell in 2019. They return to Sale, the venue of their first Preliminary Final meeting back in 1994. It's just the third time that they have met twice in the one finals series. In Leongatha's second season in this competition, 1970, they contested what was then known as the 3rd Semi-Final (the equivalent of our current 2nd Semi), then again in the Grand Final. The other occasion where they met twice in the one finals series was 1998 where, like this year, they met in the Qualifying Final and Preliminary Final. That year Leongatha won both home and away clashes, then Moe won the Qualifying Final only to see the Parrots turn it around in the Prelim. Could this year be a mirror image of 1998? Moe has won both home and away meetings with Leongatha winning the Qualifying Final. Will the Lions be able to do what the Parrots did in '98? If Leongatha wins they will be entering their seventh straight Grand Final, allowing for the COVID years. Only Traralgon in 1960 to 1966 inclusive has been able to compete in seven successive Grand Finals. Should the Lions prevail, it will be their first Grand Final since 2000, and a chance of winning their first Senior premiership since 1967.

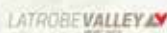
