<b>Role Overview</b>	<p>We are seeking expressions of interest from passionate and motivated coaches for opportunities across our four representative regions. We are looking for coaches that are enthusiastic about working on the individual development of Talented young footballers and are passionate about developing their own skills as coaches.</p> <p>Working in collaboration with Gippsland Power, the All-Stars head coaches will be upskilled and provided insight into Talent Pathway programs such as the Coates Talent League.</p> <p>The Gippsland All Stars will consist of fortnightly training (approx. 90 min sessions), four matchdays including a Grand Final shall your team qualify.</p>

<b>Gippsland All Stars</b>	<p>The program was established in 2021 by AFL Gippsland with six core regions and has been streamlined over recent years and now enters its fourth season thriving. With the restructure of AFL Gippsland, the program operations and administration has been transitioned to the Gippsland League who will administer the program from 2024 onwards to continue giving the Gippsland region’s junior players and coaches development and pathway opportunities leading into V/Line Cup and the Gippsland Power programs.</p> <p>Gippsland Power will be partnering with the program next year which will provide additional development prospects for the coaches in the program along with other opportunities that will be announced closer to the season.</p>
