

GAZETTE ROUND 2 WRAP UP



We got a stronger idea of where some teams sit in the Gippsland League this week. The league also held its 'Mental Health Round' to promote awareness around the issue, with all teams having a player wear blue to create conversation.

Here's what you might have missed.

Drouin v Maffra

The Hawks Nest has seen a few thrashings in the past couple of years, usually with Drouin on the wrong end of the ledger.

That wasn't the case on Saturday, however, as the Hawks got themselves on the board for season 2024 courtesy of a thumping 66-point win against Maffra.

It was a slick Hawks outfit who took the field during the 16.18 (114) to 6.12 (48) victory, a far cry from the at times disconnected team that fell to Bairnsdale in round one.

Drouin's midfield, boosted by a number of recruits, reigned supreme over the rebuilding Maffra, who held fast with the home side for stretches but ultimately couldn't stop the flood of goals.

Ex-Norwood midfielder Mitch Cotter showed every bit of the bullocking class Drouin had hoped for in a powerful performance while favourite son Eddie Morris was damaging both through the middle and up forward, where he booted three goals.

Kye Quirk top scored for the home side with four goals.

The Hawks probably could have cashed in even more on their ascendancy around the ground if not for inaccuracy – not that they'll be complaining too loudly given the past couple of years.

Perhaps most pleasing for the maroon and gold was the ruthlessness they showed in the final term. The Hawks led by 30 points at the final change, and rather than settle for a six or seven goal win, they put the young Eagles to the sword.

They will, however, have to deal with some injury concerns as experienced defender Jordan Kingi went down with a hamstring issue while Thomas Evans suffered a serious knee injury.

But outside of that was the kind of win the Hawks haven't been able to enjoy in a long time.

Spirits were lifted early when Will Papley, returning for the first time since being injured in round six last year, broke through congestion inside Drouin's forward line to snap the game's first, his teammates swarming him in jubilant celebrations.

Maffra were up for the fight early, led by the experience of James Read, Alex Carr and Kade Renooy.

The Eagles, despite their youth and the fact they are at the early stages of a rebuild, showed some nice poise with the ball in the first term to limit the quarter time margin.

The second term, however, belonged to the home side.

The polished outside ball movement that Drouin have been trying to develop clicked into gear, giving them some beautiful transition from defence to offence and allowed them repeated opportunities.

Drouin's work out of stoppages was particularly strong - where last week they were guilty of being drawn into the contest, against Maffra they held their width, winning the ball and chaining it forward.

They could have been more efficient with their chances - the Hawks kicked 5.6 to 1.4 - but at half time they were in control.

Again the visitors put up some resistance following the half time break, despite the fact they weren't finding their goals through their traditional conduits like Daniel Bedggood and John Butcher.

Keeping those two quiet would have had Hawks coach Brent Clinnick very pleased, given the pair combined for 10 goals in a game against his team last season.

Regardless the Eagles kept themselves in the hunt, albeit very faintly, going into the last.

But when Hawks forward Kye Quirk nailed a set shot minutes into the final term, those hopes were dashed and the Drouin party began.

Drouin piled on the pain late, kicking 5.7 to a lone behind to finally get a taste of what it's like being on the other side of a thumping win.

Leongatha vs Wonthaggi

Leongatha have added to Wonthaggi's early season woes, claiming a 22-point win in the grand final rematch

In a game that even echoed that famous Parrots victory at times, the green and gold put their foot on the throat early with six goals to one in the first term and didn't let up until late as they won 11.11 (77) to 8.7 (55).

Mitchell Bentvelzen played one of his finest senior games for the Parrots out of the backline while Jenson Garnham (four goals), Tallin Brill and Tom Marriott all showed their class.

The Power had their moments, winning the second and fourth quarters, but when you're down by five goals at quarter time against Leongatha chances are you won't be getting back into the match.

Much of their trouble was self-inflicted as the Power continually let themselves down coming out of the backline early to let the Parrots get the jump.

The Power kicked the first two goals of the final term to give themselves a sniff, though a strong mark and goal from Garnham put any potential comeback to rest

Aiden Lindsay, Shannon Bray and Ethan Dickison gave their all for Wonthaggi all day.

Now sitting at zero and two following their surprise loss to Warragul last week, the Power certainly aren't sitting where they would have hoped.

Next week's game against the similarly winless Morwell now looms as vital

Traralgon vs Moe

Transloon have held off a fast-finishing Moe to win a thrilling contest on Saturday night 10.14 (74) to 10.9 (69).

The Maroons looked in control of the contest at the final change of ends, leading by 28 points heading into the last.

Whatever Moe coach Declan Keilty said to his charges clearly had some effect - the Lions kicked six goals in the final quarter to give the Maroons a massive scare before just falling short.

Three of those goals were kicked by teenager Thomas Matthews, who threatened to be the unlikeliest of game winners for the Lions

Much of Traralgon's win was built off an industrious first quarter where they booted five goals to one to create an early lead, one that they ended up needing late.

Tye Hourigan was simply impassable at times as he continues to be one of the competition's premier defenders. Hugh Dunbar showed plenty, as did exciting pressure forward Liam Willaton and Luis D'Angelo.

For Moe Keilty put in a power of work, Riley Baldi's brilliant form in the middle continued and Liam Masters also played well.

The Lions clearly missed the influence of the Prowse brothers, whose height may just have given them the edge.

As things stand they'll turn their attention to an interesting match-up with Sale next week.

Morwell vs Bairnsdale

A striking fourth quarter surge saw Bairnsdale secure their second win of the year as they downed Morwell away from home.

With the lead changing hands multiple times through the day, it was ultimately five final term goals – and four of the last five – that allowed the Redlegs to pull away 13.9 (87) to 9.6 (60).

It was a meritorious win for the visitors, who trailed by 14 points late in the second term and looked as if one more goal against them might break their spirits

However, Bairnsdale looks a more resilient side in season 2024 and fought their way back into it and eventually reigned supreme.

Warragul v Sale

Warragul have continued to show they won't be a pushover in season 2024 in a spirited away loss to Sale on Saturday.

The Gulls, who defeated last year's runners-up Wonthaggi in round one, gave the Magpies a big scare before falling away late to lose 12.10 (82) to 16.13 (109).

Before the final term, however, it was anyone's guess who was going to come out on top as momentum changed hands multiple times.

Seven points was all that separated the sides heading into the fourth as the Magpies held onto a slender lead - one they would extend with five goals to two in the fourth term to run away with the game. While the visitors would have been disappointed not be leaving Sale oval with the four points, there were plenty of positives to take away from the contest

The Gulls' youth - who received a bit of a trial by fire last year thanks to the club's injury crisis - has stood up in their first two games.

Riley Senini, Luke Garner (three goals) and Lucas Carter, all of whom were playing in the club's under 18s team last year, were outstanding, putting their bodies on the line against a team boasting a wealth of experience.

Inside bull Isaac Wallace continued from where he left off last year as defensive pillars Patrick Carpenter and Sean Masterson also put in a strong body of work. The club's newfound resilience also was on display for large parts of the contest. At various times the Magpies looked primed to break Warragul's spirits with repeated inside 50s and scoring chances.

It would have been easy to see the Warragul of past seasons falling away under the pressure, losing by 10 goals or more as they so often have in recent years. The Warragul of 2024 seems to be a bit of a different beast, however.

Whenever Sale asked the question, Warragul found the answer, managing to stick around with a goal against the momentum to keep Sale within arm's reach.

In the third term they even threatened to wretch momentum away for themselves, taking the lead late in the quarter before the Magpies kicked a late major to take it back.

Ultimately though there's a reason why Sale are a perennial finals team.

They have the tools to challenge anyone, and although they maybe haven't looked quite like the best version of themselves, they know how to win. It was the usual suspect running riot too as superstar Shannen Lange ran riot through the middle.

Hudson Holmes provided plenty of class and has been a solid acquisition since crossing from Maffra before last season and Jack Leslie's performance showed why he remains one of the premier big men in the competition.

Against players of that quality you can't afford to make too many mistakes, and unfortunately for Warragul as the game went on and their younger players tired errors crept in and the home side capitalised.

Early, however, it was evident the Gulls were switched on.

Midfield maestro Tom Hobbs set the tone for the Gulls early with the first goal of the game, a long range set shot from the top of the 50 metre arc.

But just as quickly as he did, Sale key forward Brad Dessent marked and goaled from close range to show everyone that this was going to be a fight.

With the lead changing hands multiple times a Gulls upset was always on the cards, though in the end it proved to be a bridge too far.

Warragul assistant coach Sean Masterson said although it was a good showing at a ground the club had struggled at in recent times, the players were still hungry for wins

MOE'S LIAM DURKIN - 150 SENIOR GAMES

MOE winger Liam Durkin will play his 150th game today.

The left footer has been a mainstay in the reserves over the last decade, playing in some of the most eclectic teams ever assembled.

While on field success has varied, he has played in multiple finals series and kicked a total of 139 goals.

Notable club achievements include the lan Jennings Trophy for excellence on and off field in 2017.

It was perhaps fitting Durkin won an award named after the Gippsland League goal kicking great in the same year he kicked nine goals in a game - still the best individual effort by a Moe player in close to 15 years.


The 29-year-old made his debut in 2013, and has missed only one game since.

As the club statistician, he would point out there was 26 games that did not go ahead during the two cancelled seasons, so his 150th would have been reached much earlier.

Durkin has maintained the games tally of all Moe senior/reserves players for almost a decade, and is now into his ninth season writing club notes for the Record. His annual Simpsons related notes have arguably become his trademark, as have his headbands and range of hair colours. Club notes go hand-in-hand given his work as a journalist, and he has used

his media skills in other areas, including establishing a podcast interviewing various Moe Football-Netball Club identities.

He experienced his own brush with notoriety in 2019, after a video of his four bounce running goal at Ted Summerton Reserve went viral, attracting 20,000 views online.
